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A Research on the Practice of High School English Teaching Based on the Concept of Stereoscopic Classroom Model

In this trend, most teachers focus their energy on improving academic performance and neglect the cultivation of literacy. They are eager for quick success and instant benefits in classroom teaching, and cannot prioritize the comprehensive development of students, resulting in the inability to organically integrate curriculum teaching with the concept of a stereoscopic classroom model.

2. Limitations of Teaching Content

Due to the tight class hours and heavy tasks in ordinary high schools, many teachers only focus on explaining key textbook content in the teaching process in order to pursue class progress, but neglect students' comprehensive mastery of English learning, resulting in limited and singular learning methods and content scope for students. In order to cope with exams, the usual form of training is mostly limited to written expression, lacking the practice of stereoscopic learning. The arrangement system of English textbooks is to implement the core literacy goals of the subject and focus on the cultivation of quality education. If utilized well, it is a great stereoscopic teaching material. As an English teacher, we should implement subject education and full process education. The stereoscopic curriculum concept is easy to integrate into subjects such as Chinese, politics, and history, because the content of these subjects has rich examples, contains philosophy, and is easy for students to accept; Presenting a stereoscopic concept in English classrooms is difficult to grasp in operation; Many English teachers unilaterally believe that English is just a language subject. Once you have done well in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, it is enough. The main focus is on improving language application skills. Being able to learn the language well, read the text, understand grammar, and remember sentences is already very good; There are few applicable cases in English classrooms, making it difficult and time-consuming to implement stereoscopic

curriculum teaching in English classrooms. These understandings are one-sided and do not truly grasp the essence of English subject teaching.

3. Teaching Forms are Single, not Deeply Integrated

At present, most high school English teachers generally have a low level of awareness and insufficient emphasis on implementing a stereoscopic curriculum model. Some teachers, even if they have some understanding, just skim through the actual teaching and spend the vast majority of the classroom time teaching language knowledge and repeatedly practicing questions. They only end up symbolically asking questions such as "what insights did you have in this class" and "what did you learn from character stories". Students end the class before they have time to comprehend and think deeply. The lack of theme exploration and topic sublimation has greatly reduced the effectiveness of interdisciplinary teaching. In fact, integrating the concept of stereoscopic curriculum into the teaching process of high school English subject is not focused on a specific part, but rather an organic whole with emphasis but inseparable. The result of a single form and disconnected content can only be to neglect one aspect and even break down the classroom into pieces.

In the process of expanding and opening up, China's connection with the world is becoming closer, and ideological conflicts around the world are becoming increasingly fierce.

How to educate and guide students to have a correct understanding of the world situation and international issues is an indispensable and indispensable task of English curriculum. If the listening materials in some students' textbooks are relatively simple, they can be replaced with a section of music related materials from extracurricular listening books; Some of the practice questions after reading are insufficient or the information in the text lags behind. We can increase them appropriately to enable students to better understand the text and be closer to real-life situations.

(2) Integrating culture into daily teaching

Teachers should appropriately combine textbook knowledge with the local historical background and culture. Only by understanding the history, culture, traditions, customs, and lifestyles of the language country they are learning can students correctly understand and use the language. In the new textbook's units on "Man and Nature" and "Man and Society", the content is an introduction to two ancient cities in China and abroad. Teachers can compare the development history of Chinese and Western civilizations, which can not only provide students with knowledge of local customs and culture, but also guide them to think about how to make history and modern civilization harmonious and unified.

(3) Expand textbooks and broaden the depth of learning

In the curriculum reform that advocates people-oriented and comprehensive development of students, teachers should carefully design and select rich and colorful books, audiovisual materials, electronic materials, online materials, etc. that are suitable for the learning needs of different grades of students, so as to share these resources based on the actual situation of students, expand their horizons, strengthen their emotional experience, and improve the efficiency of English teaching.

4. Dealing with Stereoscopic Teaching Forms

The diversity and dimensionality of teaching forms make classroom teaching activities more vivid and vivid, which can enhance students' interest in learning and enhance classroom teaching efficiency.

(1) Stereoscopic classroom forms

Teachers can incorporate innovative ways of listening, watching, speaking, singing, and acting into the classroom. Enriching and diverse practical operations can stimulate students' interest in

learning, deepen their learning impression, improve learning efficiency, and ultimately achieve the goal of comprehensive participation in language practice activities in a relaxed and interesting atmosphere.

(2) Stereoscopic classroom activities

Teachers should carefully design activity classes, fully reflecting the principles of teacherstudent interaction and student interaction. Teachers should fully consider the joint participation and interactivity of teachers and students, and try to build a stage for student activities, allowing students to fully play in various activities, fully reflecting their autonomy and participation in learning.

(3) *Stereoscopic teaching tools*

Under the new curriculum standards, classroom teaching should not remain in the teaching mode of "blackboard+chalk", and modern information technology should be used to promote classroom teaching. Teachers can introduce modern technologies such as sound, light, and color into the classroom, presenting the knowledge points they need to teach in a three-dimensional manner, bringing vitality and energy to the classroom.

5. Stereoscopic Teaching Evaluation

(1) Multidimensional evaluation of students

Teachers should adopt a combination of formative evaluation and summative evaluation to evaluate students, comprehensively evaluating their learning process, learning awareness, emotional attitude, etc. Teachers should evaluate students according to their individual differences, and promote each student to achieve optimal development in the most suitable learning environment; We should use more motivational evaluation methods to capture the shining points and successes of students in learning activities, so that they can continuously experience progress and success in learning, establish confidence, mobilize enthusiasm, and promote the comprehensive development of their English quality.

(2) Multidimensional reflection on classroom teaching

Teachers should overcome the concept of one-time learning, establish the spirit of lifelong learning, and make every lesson an opportunity for reflection and improvement; To continuously analyze and evaluate one's teaching quality, strengthen teaching effectiveness, especially the English learning effectiveness of students at different levels; We should regularly analyze the relationship between teaching practice and student learning, approach innovation with an open mindset, combine student needs with long-term teaching goals, and combine evaluation with comprehensive quality cultivation.

After reflection, the teacher's lesson preparation needs to change over time and with different classes and students.
